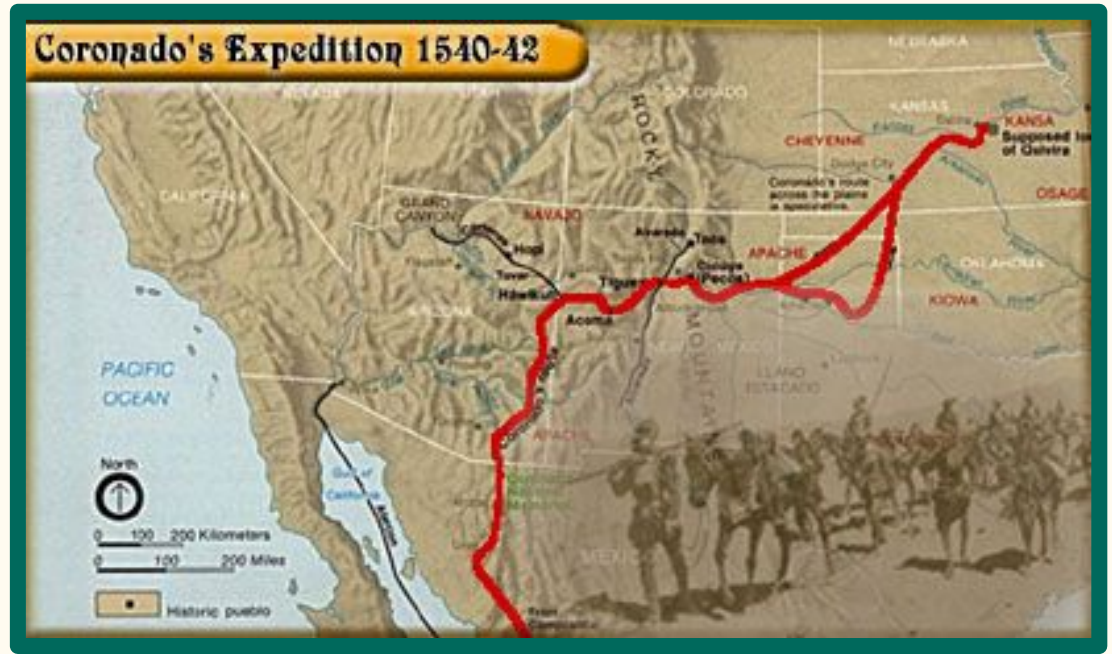


The Seven Cities of Cíbola



Vázquez de Coronado's expedition 1540-42

- 350 Spaniards
- 5 Franciscans
- 3 priests
- 2 lay brothers
- Around 1,300 Indian soldiers
- Plus additional servants and slaves
- 1,500 horses and mules
- Large herds of sheep
- A number of cattle and pigs
